Better Access Scheme



To help continue our dedicated service ORS is now offering the Medicare Better Access Scheme.

Our Medicare services provide psychological therapy to people with mental health conditions. Participants can attend their GP to obtain a referral and Mental Health Treatment Plan. This will enable the participant to access up to 10 individual and up to 10 group sessions at an ORS office with a psychologist consisting of 50-minute sessions

The first session involves an initial assessment, where the psychologist will ask lots of questions to get to know what the main areas of concern are, the goals for psychological intervention and to begin to plan how the psychology sessions will help achieve these goals.

The following sessions involve discussing presenting issues and working on specific evidence-based psychological strategies. As part of this service, the psychologist will write a progress letter back to the GP after 6 sessions, with a recommendation for a further 4 sessions, if required.

The participant can access a Medicare rebate for these sessions and ORS charges a gap fee. The full fee is payable on the day of the session, and ORS can process the Medicare rebate for the participant. Please contact us for further information about the gap fee.
