INITIAL CHILD ASSESSMENT

The Key Worker interacts with your child to understand their strengths and needs.



KEY WORKER SUPPORT

The Key Worker will provide support during regular sessions for your child and family to reach their goals.



PROGRESS REPORT

At 11 months, the Key Worker can provide a progress report for all the goals and include recommendations. You can use this report for your NDIS plan review to advocate for future support.













INITIAL **INTERVIEW**

Initial routines based interview and assessment with family/carer.



PLAN DEVELOPMENT

The Key Worker, together with the family/carer, defines achievable goals and develops the Child and Family Support Plan.



REFERRAL TO OTHER SERVICES

The Key Worker may start to refer your child to other services such as Psychology, OT, Speech Pathology, Dietetics, Physiotherapy, or Exercise Physiology.
